### INTRODUCTION

When you need to find the telephone number of your nearest local organisation, address of a local school, local authority services or where to find a local sports club, where should you look?

You could resort to thumbing through page after page of a directory or search the internet. But how much quicker and easier it is to keep this little Residents' Guide at hand.

In this Guide you will find a wealth of local references. The Guide is designed for those living in Holbrook and Roffey areas of North Horsham – *or planning to move into the area.*

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE AREA

There are three tiers of local government with areas of responsibility in North Horsham – West Sussex County Council, Horsham District Council and North Horsham Parish Council (see pages 22 & 23 of the Guide).

It is hoped the following brief description of each Council's role will help demystify who does what!!

**West Sussex County Council's** responsibilities include (not an exhaustive list):

- **Adult Social Care**, working on partnership with West Sussex Primary Care Trust and others, to assess the needs of and commission services for older people and those with disabilities, either in their own homes or in residential placements;
- **Waste Disposal**, such as by landfill or possibly in the future, incineration.
- **Children's Services**, supporting school improvement, commissioning services for children and families through Children's Centres, managing fostering and adoption;
- **Transport and Environment**, including road safety; the maintenance of footways, roads and bridges and street lighting; support for public transport; rights of way and access to the countryside; and protection of the Downs;
- **Education**, primary and secondary, adult education, skills for life;
- A range of other services, including Libraries, Archives and Records Management, Trading Standards, Adult Community Learning and the Registration Service.

**Horsham District Council's** responsibilities include (not an exhaustive list):

- Housing the homeless (ultimately by placement in housing association accommodation)
- Determining planning applications
- Rubbish/recycling collections from premises (domestic and commercial); provision of recycling facilities
- Street cleansing
- Environmental health
- Licensing of taxis, premises and individuals
- Provision of leisure and sports facilities, such as the Pavilions in the Park, recreation grounds
- Collection of the Council Tax on behalf of all three tiers of local government and the Sussex Police Authority.

**North Horsham Parish Council** currently provides the following for the local community:

- **The Parish Office in Roffey Millennium Hall**, Crawley Road acts as an information point for local residents. The premises were built in 2000. The premises offer easy public access at street level. There is a lift to the upper floor. For further details and activities at the hall see Page 5 of the Guide.
- **Two further Community Halls – North Heath Hall** in St Marks Lane and **The Tythe Barn** in Pondtail Road. Details of activities at these two venues are detailed separately in the Guide (pages 7 to 9).
- The Council also owns **Holbrook Recreation Ground**, Pondtail Road (site of

The Tythe Barn) that includes **two multi purpose floodlit courts** – currently used mainly for 5-side soccer teams and a Netball Club. It is hoped that Tennis Coaching may soon be available also (through The Holbrook Club).

- **Four children’s play areas** owned and maintained by the Parish Council - at **Birches Road, Amberley Close, Earles Meadow and Holbrook Recreation Ground**. Each play area has been either totally renewed or updated in the past three years and are very attractively designed and well used. Other recreation grounds and play areas are the responsibility of Horsham District Council. (see page 10)
- Three **Open Spaces** are owned and maintained by the Parish Council. These are located in **Birches Road, Amberley Close/Rowlands Road and a 13-acre site at Earles Meadow**.
- There are a number of small **allotment sites** throughout North Horsham. The only one owned by the Parish Council is at **Amberley Close/Rowlands Road (18 plots) and is fully booked with a waiting list**. Another site off Harwood Road is leased from West Sussex County Council and currently run by the Harwood Road Allotment Society. Other allotment sites are owned by Horsham District Council (tel. 01403 215100)
- The Parish Council owns and maintains a very **small number of street lamps** – mainly in the Cook Road/Amundsen Road area. They are located in the twittens that join up the houses but do not include any street lights on the roadways. The Council also owns **10 bus shelters**.
- **Part of Roffey Cemetery** is owned by the Parish Council. However, all maintenance is undertaken by Horsham District Council who charges the Parish Council accordingly.
- There are 10 Parish Council **noticeboards** around North Horsham, which are used for the display of Parish Council meetings, Agendas and a list of Councillors. Over the past two years the older noticeboards have been replaced and a new **Poster Display Roundal** just been installed on the corner of Crawley Road and
